**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LINCOLN
AMENDING RESOLUTION 2020-22 AS AMENDED BY RESOLUTION 2020-
26, CONCERNING DISPLACED LINCOLN COUNTY RESIDENTS CAUSED BY
THE ECHO MOUNTAIN COMPLEX FIRE**

RECITALS

WHEREAS, The Red Cross, followed by the Oregon Department of Human Services, have been using various private hotel and motel properties for emergency sheltering of Lincoln County residents, displaced by the Echo Mountain Complex Fire; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to specifically authorize this use for the duration of the emergency, pursuant to specific authority in the emergency operations ordinance, and previously approved Resolutions 2020-22 and 2020-26;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LINCOLN CITY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. RECITALS. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 3, Paragraph G of Resolution 2020-22, as amended by Resolution 2020-26, is hereby further amended to add the following bullet point to the end of Paragraph G:

- Pursuant to the authority granted in LCMC 17.80.140, the following private property is designated for emergency operations uses, specifically for extended stay accommodations for fire victims, for the duration of the housing emergency as detailed in Resolution 2020-22, as amended:

- Ashley Inn, 3430 NE Highway 101 Lincoln City, OR
- Comfort Inn & Suites, 136 NE HWY 101 Lincoln City, OR
- Motel 6, 3517 NW Hwy 101 Lincoln City, OR
- Seagull Beachfront, 1511 NW Harbor Ave Lincoln City, OR
- Travelodge by Windham, 1713 NW 21st St. Lincoln City, OR

1 **SECTION 3. NO OTHER AMENDMENT.** The remainder of Section 3, Paragraph G
2 of Resolution 2020-22, as amended by Resolution 2020-26, remains unchanged. All
3 other Subparagraphs, Paragraphs, Sections, and Exhibits to Resolution 2020-22 and
4 Resolution 2020-26, (other than the addition to Section 3, Paragraph G above),
5 remain in full force and effect.

6 **SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This resolution is effective as of the date of its
7 adoption and signature by the Mayor.
