10	Pursuant to LCMC 10.08.010, the City Council may exercise Traffic and Parking Control
11	authority by Resolution of the Council; and
12	
13	The closure of streets, either permanently or temporarily for safety reasons, is
14	expressly listed as within the authority of the City Council; and
15	
16	The City Council has mandated in the code that the exercise of municipal traffic
17	control and parking authority be based upon engineering and safety considerations,
18	and not on any other basis; and
19	as a second of a second of the heach via the
20	On June 26, and June 27, 2021 uncontrolled vehicular access to the beach via the NW 15 th Street beach access caused numerous dangerous situations, including
21	unsafe vehicular operation in the vicinity of pedestrians, operation of vehicles
22 23	outside authorized areas, stuck vehicles due to incoming tides, multiple tow truck
23 24	and public safety (police and fire) deployments; and
25	
26	The crush of vehicular traffic in the vicinity of the NW 15th Street beach access
27	(between 100 to 200 vehicles), including stuck vehicles, caused a bottleneck of traffic
28	stopping some vehicles from leaving, and prohibiting emergency vehicles from
29	entering; and
30	the state of light holiday
31	The continued extreme heat in the valley and the upcoming Fourth of July holiday
32	weekend promises a more intense and more dangerous situation at this beach access if no action is taken to reduce the conflicts created when vehicles access the
33	beach, a driving environment not suited for most vehicular traffic; and
34 35	beach, a driving environment not suited for most verneaut training
36	The City Council finds and determines that there exists an engineering and public
37	safety basis for an exercise of municipal parking and traffic control authority,
38	specifically to temporarily prohibit vehicular traffic on NW 15 th Street from Harbor
39	Ave to the beach, except or public safety / emergency vehicles; and

1 2 3 4 5	Closure of NW 15 th Street will necessitate a companion closure of NW 34 th Court (sometimes mistakenly referred to as "36 th Street beach access" or "35 th Court"), to avoid all beach traffic moving to that location; and
	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LINCOLN CITY, AS FOLLOWS:
7	SECTION 1. RECITALS.
9 10 11	The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.
12	SECTION 2. IMPOSING TRAFFIC CONTROL FOR TEMPORARY PERIOD.
13 14 15	Effective upon posting of appropriate signage prohibiting vehicular access, (except for emergency vehicles) by the City Public Works Department, the requested exercise of parking and traffic control authority is hereby approved, specifically,
16 17 18 19	NW 15 th Street is temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic from Harbor Avenue to the beach, excepting access by public safety and emergency vehicles on official business. Some limited parking may be provided.
20 21 22 23	NW 34 th Court is temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic from NW Jetty Avenue to the beach, excepting access by public safety and emergency vehicles on official business. Some limited parking may be provided.
24252627	The precise closure is depicted on the attached map set forth in Exhibit A and incorporated herein by this reference.
28 29 30	The closure concerns areas of the City of Lincoln city public street right-of-way outside the jurisdiction of Oregon State Parks. The closure shall be effective beginning 12:00 PM, Tuesday, June 29, 2021 through 12:00 PM, July 13, 2021.
31	SECTION 3. POSTING OF SIGNAGE & NOTICE TO ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.
32 33 34 35 36 37 38	The Public Works Department is directed to erect Road Closed or other appropriate signage in the appropriate locations to notify the public that vehicular traffic is prohibited on NW 15 th Street and NW 34 th Court, that the beach access for vehicles is effectively closed. Pedestrian access to the beach via the NW 15 th Street segment and 34 th Court segment noted herein is expressly authorized. City police and code enforcement officers are to be advised of the temporary restrictions by City

- Administration. City Administration shall post the closure on the City's webpage.
 Failure to observe the posted traffic control measure is a Class B violation and may be cited under Lincoln City Municipal Code Chapter 1.16.

 SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution is effective as of the date of its adoption.


