6 7 8	RECITALS
9 10 11	Pursuant to LCMC 10.08.010, the City Council may exercise Traffic Control and Parking Control authority by Resolution of the Council; and
12 13 14	The establishment of parking limitations is expressly listed as within the authority of the City Council; and
15 16 17	In December 2020 Council passed a series of motions concerning traffic control studies and actions; one of those motions concerned overnight camping; and
18 19 20 21	For purposes of parking and camping, the term "overnight" is defined as between 2:30 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. Overnight (2:30 am – 5:00 am) camping or resting in your vehicle is prohibited in City and URA parking lots, parks and in city street right-of-way; and
22 23 24 25 26 27	To provide additional legal places for persons to rest, Council recently amended the overnight camping ordinance to expand the permitted camping exception to include invehicle camping / resting on lots owned by not-for profit entities under certain specified conditions (expanding the previous allowance under state law which was restricted to religious institutions). (See LCMC 9.08.055)
28 29 30	As an additional option, Council would like to designate certain public parking spaces for emergency in-vehicle overnight (2:30 am $-$ 5:00 am) resting, subject to conditions, including but not limited to time limitations and a permit requirement; and
31 32 33 34 35	The City Council finds and determines that there is a public benefit to establishment of limited overnight camping / resting allowances, by permit, in certain public parking locations owned or controlled by the City and Urban Renewal Agency.
36 37	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LINCOLN CITY, AS FOLLOWS:
38 39 40	SECTION 1. RECITALS . The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.
41 42 43	SECTION 2. IMPOSING TRAFFIC AND PARKING CONTROL – OVERNIGHT RESTING / IN-VEHICLE CAMPING.

Effective upon posting of required signage, described below, "Overnight Camping / Resting with Permit" spaces are hereby authorized and approved in the City and URA owned or controlled lots listed on Attachment 1. The Manager, after consultation with the City Engineer, shall be solely responsible for designation of spaces, not to exceed one space per lot.

38		3. LCMC 9.08.055.A.3 expressly authorizes overnight camping in-vehicle
39		resting if set forth in an approved traffic & parking control resolution.

41		permit, is a Class C violation. Failure to vacate an Overnight Camping /
42		Resting space by 9:00 a.m. after permitted overnight use is a Class B
43		violation.

4. The City Manager is hereby directed to cause appropriate signage for the designated spaces to be installed and further to implement a permit process at the appropriate city department. The Manager may use alternate wording on the signage. SECTION 4. THIS RESOLUTION DOES NOT AUTHORIZE OVERNIGHT PARKING OR CAMPING IN BEACH ACCESS LOTS OR ON THE OCEAN SHORE. SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.
