3 **A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LINCOLN CITY AMENDING RESOLUTION**
4 **2021-45 PROVIDING FOR EXTENSION OF THE STREET CLOSURE OF A PORTION**
5 **OF NW 34TH COURT**

6
7 **RECITALS**

8
9 Pursuant to LCMC 10.08.010, the City Council passed Resolution 2021-31, Resolution
10 2021-34, 2021-37, 2021-38 and 2021-45 which concern the exercise of Traffic and
11 Parking Control authority in temporarily closing portions of NW 15th Street and/or
12 NW 34th Court; and

13
14 The closures effectively eliminated vehicular access to the beach from the referenced
15 streets, excepting provisions made for ADA access and emergency vehicles; and

16
17 The 15th Street closure has already lapsed; the 34th Court closure will lapse on April
18 30, 2022; and

20 Council requested a review of the closures prior to the end of April 2022 to determine
21 if extensions are warranted; and

23 The Council desires to amend Resolution 2021-45 to extend the duration of the
24 closure of NW 34th Court to December 31, 2022; and

26 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF**
27 **LINCOLN CITY, AS FOLLOWS:**

28 **SECTION 1. RECITALS.**

30 The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this
31 reference.

33 **SECTION 2. EXTENSION OF CLOSURE OF NW 34th COURT.**

34 The temporary closure of NW 34th Court as directed in Resolution 2021-45, and
35 previous Resolutions is hereby extended to December 31, 2022.

1 **SECTION 3. REVIEW OF NW 15th STREET.**

2 The City Manager is directed to track complaints regarding beach access via NW
3 15th Street and report to Council in June 2022. The issue of any further closure of
4 NW 15th will be addressed at that time.

5 **SECTION 4. ALL OTHER PROVISIONS REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.**

6
7 Other provisions of prior Orders (such as City Manager authority to order the closure
8 of NW 15th and NW 34th Court, or any other city street or city beach access during
9 dangerous beach conditions) remain in full force and effect.



11 **SECTION 5. PENALTY.** Failure to observe the closure of NW 34th Court or any
12 other closure under this or prior Council Traffic Control Resolutions is a Class B
13 violation and may be cited under Lincoln City Municipal Code Chapter 1.16.

14 **SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Resolution is effective as of the date of its
15 adoption.


