8 9	Pursuant to LCMC 10.08.010, the City Council may exercise Traffic and Parking Control authority
10	by Resolution of the Council; and
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12	The establishment of parking controls, including but not limited to parking areas and time
13	limitations, prohibited parking, parking permits and metered parking is expressly listed as within
14	the authority of the City Council; and
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16 17	The minimum width for a travel way on a low use local street is twenty (20) feet; and
18	NW 8 th Court has inadequate road width to allow for on-street parking; and
19	1444 o Court has madequate road width to allow for on street parking, and
20	Conflicts between residents concerning parking in the right-of-way, the safe passage of
21	emergency and service vehicles, and other unauthorized "improvements" and obstructions of
22	the travel way, necessitate City action; and
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24	On August 11, 2022 the City Manager, pursuant to delegated authority in LCMC 10.08.020.C.,
25	issued a traffic control order prohibiting parking in the right-of-way on 8th Court, including both
26 27	sides of the street; and
28	The Order was not appealed and has been enforced with citations; and
29	The Order was not appeared and has been emoreed with citations, and
30	Periodically, Traffic Control Orders need to be compiled on a Schedule and brought to the
31	attention of Council;
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33	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LINCOLN CITY,
34	AS FOLLOWS:
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36	SECTION 1. RECITALS . The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated
37 38	herein by this reference.
39	SECTION 2. IMPOSING TRAFFIC / PARKING CONTROL.
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41	No parking will be permitted in the City right of way of NW 8 th Court, on either side of the
42	street. No part of a vehicle parked on private property shall encroach on City right-of-way.
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14 15	SECTION 3. POSTING OF SIGNAGE & NOTICE TO ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.
16 17 18	The Public Works Department is directed to erect no parking signs in the appropriate locations and City police and code enforcement officers are to be advised of the parking restrictions by City Administration.
50 51 52	SECTION 4. REPLACMENT. This Resolution replaces the City Manager's Traffic Control Order dated August 11, 2020.
53 54 55 56	SECTION 5. PENALTY. Pursuant to Municipal Code, violation of this Order is punishable as a Class B Violation. Maximum fine \$1000.00, plus assessments per offense and a minimum fine of \$135.00, plus assessments.
57	SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution is effective as of the date of its adoption.
