4 **A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LINCOLN CITY, ADOPTING FINDINGS FOR A PUBLIC**  
5 **CONTRACT EXEMPTION AND AUTHORIZING AN ALTERNATIVE CONTRACTING**  
6 **METHOD FOR THE HOLMES ROAD SANITARY PUMP STATION UPGRADE**  
7 **CONSTRUCTION PROJECT**

9 **RECITALS**

11 **WHEREAS**, ORS 279C.335(2) permits the City Council, acting as the Local Contract Review  
12 Board, to exempt a public improvement contract or class of contracts from the competitive  
13 bidding requirements of the Lincoln City Public Contracting Code and use an alternative  
14 contracting method, subject to making required findings; and  
15

16 **WHEREAS**, on August 8, 2022, the City Council conducted an advertised public hearing on  
17 the proposed findings to exempt the Holmes Road Sanitary Pump Station Upgrade  
18 Construction Project from competitive bidding and authorize an alternative public  
19 contracting method; and

21 **WHEREAS**, on August 8, 2022, after due consideration of public comment and the proposed  
22 findings in the record, the City Council, acting as the Local Contract Review Board, deliberated  
23 and decided to approve the exemption and authorize the alternative contracting method; and

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LINCOLN**  
26 **CITY, AS FOLLOWS:**

28 **SECTION 1. RECITALS.** The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated  
29 herein by this reference.

31 **SECTION 2 . APPROVAL.** The City Council, acting as the Local Contract Review Board,  
32 hereby approves the required Findings to support the exemption from competitive bidding  
33 and the use of an alternative contracting method for the Holmes Road Sanitary Pump Station  
34 Upgrade Construction Project, said findings being attached to this Resolution and  
35 incorporated herein by this reference; and

37 **SECTION 3 . EFFECTIVE DATE.** This resolution is effective as of the date of its adoption and  
38 signature by the Mayor or Council President.
