4 **A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LINCOLN CITY DESIGNATING ADDITIONAL ADJACENT**
5 **LANDS AS INTERIM PARK PROPERTY FOR INTERIM PARK USE, SUBJECT TO**
6 **PERMITTING AND REGULATIONS UNDER LCMC CHAPTER 12.16 (PARK REGULATIONS)**
7 **AND CHAPTER 10.08 (TRAFFIC CONTROL AUTHORITY)**

8 **RECITALS:**

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10 The City of Lincoln City Parks Department regulates City Parks and Interim City Parks under
11 Chapter 12.16 of the Municipal Code; and

13 Comprehensive Plan Map and Zone map amendments concerning the limits of the Park zone
14 and Open Space areas in the vicinity of Kids Park in Cutler City and Canyon Park are being
15 examined together with other amendments to clean up Park Zone designated lands in the
16 City; and

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18 City staff requests an interim Park designation of the areas adjacent to Kids Park and Canyon
19 Park in order to extend park regulations, including park speed limits, for an interim period
20 while changes to zoning are reviewed; and

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22 The Interim Park designation of the subject property is not a zoning designation and does
23 not authorize any physical alteration or development that would be inconsistent with the
24 previously approved plans and conditions; and

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26 Accordingly, in order to properly regulate and control interim Park use, the City Council
27 establishes herein the interim regulations applicable to the subject property as follows:

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29 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Lincoln City,
30 that pursuant to Lincoln City Municipal Code Chapter 12.16, the City Council issues the
31 following Interim Park designation and regulations for the subject properties:

- 33 1. The recitals set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated herein by
34 this reference; and
 - 35
36 2. Pursuant to Section 12.16. 005, the subject properties (as described and shown on
37 Exhibit A (KIDS PARK), and Exhibit B (CANYON PARK), attached hereto and made a
38 part hereof by this reference, are hereby designated for Interim Park use
39 consistent with this Resolution; and

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- 3. The regulations contained in Chapter 12.16 (PARK REGULATIONS) and Chapter 10.08 (TRAFFIC CONTROL AUTHORITY), of the Lincoln City Municipal Code, as they may be amended, apply fully to the subject properties.
- 4. Access to the subject property is without charge for passive recreation uses; all persons enter the property at their own risk.
- 5. Violation of the provisions of Chapter 12.16 and Chapter 10.08 and this Order shall be enforced by civil penalties as provided in Chapter 12.16.050 Lincoln City Municipal Code.
- 6. This resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
- 7. This resolution establishing interim Park use will automatically terminate upon the approval of any plan and zone amendments for the subject properties, unless Council elects to extend or terminate the resolution earlier.



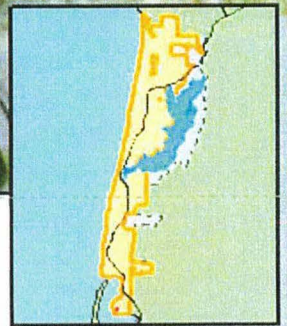
Location
