On the Planning Commission voted to transmit the amendment to the City Council with a 12 recommendation that the ordinance be adopted; and 13 Whereas, the City Council conducted a public hearing on , 2024 closed 14 the hearing, closed the record, and deliberated on the proposed amendment; and 15 Whereas, all persons were given an opportunity to provide written and/or oral testimony on the proposed ordinance amendment, 16 The City of Lincoln City Ordains as follows: 17 Section 1: LCMC Section 16.12.210 (Lots- General Requirements) is hereby deleted in its 18 entirety as follows: 19 The lot size, width, shape and orientation shall be appropriate for the location of the 20 subdivision and for the type of development and use contemplated. 21 Section 2: LCMC Section 16.12.220 (Minimum Lot Sizes) is hereby deleted in its entirety as follows: 22 23 A. The lot sizes, in addition to conformance with LCMC Title 17, shall be not less than as given in the following table:
