2 **WHEREAS**, the City Council further expressed its position (5-2 vote) that the 24 hour
3 hold applicable to lodging operators be lifted.

4
5 **WHEREAS**, Lincoln County, in County Orders 6-20-168 and 6-20-169 both reduced
6 the social gathering limit to ten (10) persons and retained the 24 hour hold provision
7 for lodging operators; and

8
9 **WHEREAS**, the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners chair noted the City's
10 different position and the Council finds it necessary and convenient to formally
11 reduce the Council's action which is inconsistent with the County's orders to writing
12 to highlight the City's different position within the City limits of the City of Lincoln
13 City; and

14
15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF**
16 **LINCOLN CITY, AS FOLLOWS:**

17
18 **SECTION 1. RECITALS.** The above recitals are true and correct and are
19 incorporated herein by this reference.

20
21 **SECTION 2. EXTENSION.** All extensions previously approved by the City
22 Manager are hereby ratified. The Manager's delegated authority to extend the
23 emergency declaration without further action of the Council remains in full force and
24 effect.

25
26 **SECTION 3. CONCURRENCE/ EXCEPTIONS.** The City of Lincoln City concurs with all
27 Lincoln County Emergency orders and reopening plans except in two respects:

28
29 Within the City of Lincoln City, the Phase 1 reopening twenty five (25) person
30 limit for social gatherings is not reduced to ten (10) persons; and

31
32 Within the City of Lincoln City, the 24 hour hold imposed by County Order and
33 applicable to lodging operators is no longer in effect. Notwithstanding the
34 above, in accordance with CDC guidelines when a person suspected or
35 confirmed to have COVID-19 has occupied a room or establishment, the 24
36 hour CDC imposed hold is in full force and effect.

1 **SECTION 4. FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.** All other provisions of the County and City
2 Emergency Declaration Resolutions and Orders and actions taken, not specifically
3 amended or distinguished herein, remain in full force and effect.

4
5 **SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Order is effective on June 22, 2020 and shall
6 continue until terminated or when the emergency declaration expires, whichever
7 occurs earlier.
