4	RECITALS
5	
6	At its special City Council meeting on March 16, 2020, the City Council approved
7	Resolution 2020-06 declaring an Emergency as a result of the COVID -19 Pandemic.
8	
9	Resolution 2020-06, Section 2. Paragraph F declares an emergency through April 8,
10	2020 but provides for extension of the emergency by the City Manager as follows:
11	
12	F. An estimate of the length of time during which the designated area will
13	remain under the emergency declaration; and
14	
15	Through April 8, 2020, but may be extended by the City Manager without
16	further Order of the Council for two week increments each extension or
17	for increments consistent with State of Oregon emergency declarations.

18	By Order under the above cited authority in Pacalutian 2020, 06, the City Manager
19	By Order, under the above cited authority in Resolution 2020-06, the City Manager extended the duration of the COVID-19 emergency to April 28, 2020; and
20 21	extended the duration of the COVID-19 emergency to April 20, 2020, and
22	On March 23, 2020, the City Manager for the City of Lincoln City concurred with
23	Lincoln County Order 3-23-85 prohibiting short term rentals and lodging, among
24	other things, and the City Council, by unanimous vote, on March 23, 2020 ratified the
25	Manager's concurrence; and
26	
27	On April 27, 2020, the City Council by approval of Resolution 2020-11, extended the
28	Declaration of Emergency to May 31, 2020, ratifying therein all City Manager Orders,
29	announcements and imposed restrictions as set forth in various press releases; and
30	
31	The State of Oregon declaration of emergency has been extended by the governor to
32	July 6, 2020; and
33	
34	On May 13, 2020 the governor approved Lincoln County's reopening application; and
35	
36	On May 14, 2020 after consulting with Lincoln County cities at a special joint meeting,
37	the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners approved Order 5-20-136, modifying
38	prior Board orders to approve a phased reopening plan; and
39	

- On May 14, 2020, by motion at a special joint meeting of the City Council, Lincoln
- 2 County and other cities, the City Council for the City of Lincoln City concurred with
- the County re-opening plan [Order 5-20-136] which, among other things, allows for
- 4 short term rental and lodging reopening, subject to listed restrictions, on June 1,
- 5 2020; and

- 7 NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY GRANTED IN LINCOLN CITY
- 8 MUNICIPAL CODE, CHAPTER 2.72 AND RESOLUTION 2020-06, THE CITY
  - MANAGER OF THE CITY OF LINCOLN CITY DOES HEREBY ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

- 14 SECTION 2. EXTENSION OF EMERGENCY DECLARATION. The duration of
- the emergency declaration in Resolution 2020-06 is hereby amended and extended
- from May 31, 2020 to and through July 6, 2020, consistent with State of Oregon
- 17 emergency declarations.

- 19 **SECTION 3. AMENDMENT.** All other provisions of the Emergency Declaration not
- 20 specifically amended herein remain in full force and effect.
- 21 **SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Order is effective immediately upon its
- signature by the City Manager.
