1	SECOND ORDER EXTENDING EMERGENCY DECLARATION
2	SET FORTH IN RESOLUTION NO. 2020-06
3	
4	<u>RECITALS</u>
5	
6	At its special City Council meeting on March 16, 2020, the City Council approved Resolution
7	2020-06 declaring an Emergency as a result of the COVID -19 Pandemic.
8	
9	Resolution 2020-06, Section 2. Paragraph F declares an emergency through April 8, 2020 but
10	provides for extension of the emergency by the City Manager as follows:
11	
12	F. An estimate of the length of time during which the designated area will remain
13	under the emergency declaration; and
14	
15	Through April 8, 2020, but may be extended by the City Manager without furthe
16	Order of the Council for two week increments each extension or for increments
17	consistent with State of Oregon emergency declarations.
18	The City Manager entered an Order (First Extension Order) extending the emergency
19	declaration, consistent with the State of Oregon emergency declarations, extending the
20	duration from April 8, 2020 to and through April 28, 2020; and
21	daration from April 6, 2020 to and through April 20, 2020, and
22	NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY GRANTED IN LINCOLN CITY
23	MUNICIPAL CODE, CHAPTER 2.72 AND RESOLUTION 2020-06, THE CITY MANAGER OF
24	THE CITY OF LINCOLN CITY DOES HEREBY ORDER AS FOLLOWS:
25	
26	SECTION 1. RECITALS. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated
27	herein by this reference.
28	
29	SECTION 2. SECOND EXTENSION OF EMERGENCY DECLARATION. The duration of
30	the emergency declaration in Resolution 2020-06, as previously extended, is hereby further
31	amended and extended from April 29, 2020 to and through May 31, 2020.
32	
33	SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. All other provisions of the Emergency Declaration not
34	specifically amended herein remain in full force and effect.
35	SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Order is effective immediately upon its signature by the
36	City Manager.
