11	intermediate and small Procurements set forth in the Attorney General Model Rules; and

13	WHEREAS, Section 2.05.050 specifically authorizes the City Council to limit,
14	condition or restrict the delegation to the City Manager by Resolution; and
15	
16	WHEREAS, Section 2.05.050 further authorizes the City Council to identify by
17	Resolution "Designated Staff" eligible to receive public contracting authority and further
18	permits the City Manager to limit, condition or restrict the delegation to the Designated
19	Staff by Written Order; and
20	
21	WHEREAS, Resolution 2016-12 concerned the delegation of public contracting
22	authority for fiscal year 2016-2017 and expires according to its own terms on June 30,
23	2017; and
24	WHEREAS, Resolution 2017-06 concerned the delegation of public contracting
25	authority for fiscal year 2017-2018; and
26	
27	WHEREAS, City Administration has hired a Parks and Recreation Director and the
28	position is not reflected on Resolution 2017-06; and
29	
30	WHEREAS, this Resolution replaces Resolution 2017-06 and now correctly
31	reflects all Departments with delegated contract authority.

33	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
34	LINCOLN CITY, AS FOLLOWS:

9	Procurement or as otherwise designated in LCMC 2.05.050, the City Manager's			
10	authority for fiscal year 2017-2018 is limited to fifty percent (50%) of the			
11	applicable Attorney General Model Contracting Rules limit, including but not			
12	limited to the following:

14 15	a. Personal & Professional Services: \$50,000.			
15 16	b. Public Improvements: \$50,000.			
10 17	c. Materials and Trade Services: \$75,000.			
18	2. Legal review: When Procurement includes a contract, the contract shall be in a			
19	standard approved city form or the contract shall be reviewed and approved as			
20	to form by the City Attorney.

22	3. Legally available funds : The purchase order system shall include an			
23	identification of the line item(s) or account numbers(s) where legally available			
24	funds are budgeted for the project. If restricted funds are used (such as grant or			
25	bond funds) the purchase order system shall identify the restricted source of the			
26	funds.

28	4. Activity Report: A report to Council shall be prepared by the City Manager prior			
29	to the end of each fiscal year listing all intermediate Procurements and contracts			
30	above \$25,000, entered into pursuant to the delegation of contracting authority			
31	pursuant to LCMC 2.05.050.
