5 6 7	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Lincoln City, along with its staff and citizens, recognize the importance of developing and maintaining healthy neighborhoods throughout the city and the adjacent urban growth area; and
8 9 10	WHEREAS, the City of Lincoln City has adopted a policy in its Comprehensive Plan to encourage a variety of citizen programs such as neighborhood associations and other committees to serve in the interest of the community; and
11 12 13 14	WHEREAS, the City of Lincoln City has adopted a Citizen Involvement Program that describes well-organized neighborhood associations as the backbone of any successful citizen involvement program and encourages their formation throughout the city and the urban growth boundary; and
15 16 17	WHEREAS, the Roads End Improvement Association has submitted an application for recognition as a neighborhood association that substantially meets the criteria for such recognition;
18 19 20 21 22 23	WHEREAS, on August 11, 2014, the City Council approved Resolution 2014-20, which recognized the Roads End Improvement Association as a neighborhood association, with the proviso that within a year of Resolution 2014-20's passage the Roads End Improvement Association amend its Bylaws to include a means for designating spokespeople, means to maintain a current address, and a means for resolving grievances;

WHEREAS, on July 13, 2015, the City Council were advised that the Roads End Improvement Association had amended its Policies and Procedures manual to address Council's concerns;


WHEREAS, amending the Policies and Procedures manual rather than the Bylaws is satisfactory to Council; and
