28	findings, and the additional findings set forth in Exhibit A attached, the disposal of			

- 1 property described in Section 1 is determined exempt from competitive bid under Lincoln
- 2 City Municipal Code §2.05.080(L).
- 3 Section 5. City staff is authorized to dispose of or sell or trade the surplus property
- 4 described in Section 1 in a manner most likely to result in the greatest net revenue to the
- 5 City of Lincoln City.
